CURRICULUM

In addition to offering religious instruction and weekly worship, St. Mark integrates Christian principles and values throughout the entire curriculum. Our students have always been well prepared academically to be successful when they reach the high school level.

Accelerated Courses: Pre-algebra, Algebra and (Integrated Physics & Chemistry) IPC, English

Electives: Spanish, Choir, Band, Orchestra, Musical Theater, Art, Health

Extra Curricular: Sports, Music Conservatory, Spelling Bee, Scouting Programs, and Academic Competitions (PSIA Private School Interscholastic Association) Other after-school programs are available on campus through our Extended Care Program that includes several activities such as Ballet/Tap/Jazz, Tumbling, City Artworks, Kid Fit, Giggle Bytes, and Little Amigos.

Competitive Sports: 5th through 8th Grade -Soccer, Cross Country, Track, Basketball, Volleyball, Baseball, Softball, Cheerleading.

Youth Sports: Kindergarten through 4th grade participate in the West Houston Christian League in soccer, basketball, baseball, and softball, as well as basketball and volleyball camps Sponsored by St. Mark's Athletics Department.

Library: Over 20,000 Volumes, Accelerated Reader Program.

Technology: Classes for K-8. One computer lab with 28 computers and an additional 20 laptop computers. All classrooms have networked computers and filtered Internet access. Classrooms are equipped with Smartboards for computer enhanced instruction.

Chapel: Weekly chapel service every Wednesday morning. Parents and guests are encouraged and welcome to attend.

Lunch Program: St. Mark has a fully staffed cafeteria that serves hot lunches daily.
